







Join Clearwater Farm for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Youth Education Gardens program. We are excited to offer a weekly, summer-long program for youth groups, daycare centers, and other organizations interested in learning about gardening, sustainability, and healthy living.

#### What will we do each week?

- Learn how to plant, care for, and harvest an organic garden.
- Explore nature at the farm and meet our friendly farm animals.
- Grow personally and socially by exploring new skills and interests and participating in teambuilding activities.
- Create sustainable art by upcycling discarded materials.
- Prepare delicious, nutritious snacks using fresh garden produce.

## When is the program offered?

Your group will work with our garden teacher for 1.5 hours each week, beginning the week of June 12 and ending the week of August 14. We will work with you to find a day and time that works best for your group. We offer morning and afternoon time slots, Monday -Thursday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. You are welcome to stay longer and enjoy a picnic lunch before or after your scheduled time.

#### How many and what ages can attend?

We can accommodate up to 15 participants at one time. If you have a large group, you are welcome to sign up multiple groups and double the size of your garden. This program is designed for ages 5 and up. Adult clients are welcome, too!

### How much does the program cost?

We are asking that each group contribute \$150 to help sustain our garden program for future years. Fee waivers are available for groups with demonstrated need thanks to generous community support.

#### What are the group's responsibilities?

We ask that group leaders communicate with the garden teacher regarding the group's needs, provide chaperones each week to help supervise and assist with activities, and if possible, bring the same participants to the program each week to experience the entire garden process from seed to table.
